Contractor Management & Compliance

Who needs to read this?

All Curtin University Staff and Contractors.

Background

Curtin University has strengthened its contractor management system within Rapid Global. The following statuses will be applied to companies within the system:

- Compliant – Once pre-qualified this status will be applied indicating that the requirements of the University have been met
- Conditional Standing – Applied to a company due to repeated non-compliance within a period of 12 months. This status places a temporary restriction/limitation on a company's ability to undertake or continue to undertake work at Curtin University whilst under review or for a period of 12 months. This may require the company to meet additional requirements or conditions.
- Suspended- A temporary status that immediately prevents a company from undertaking or continuing to undertake work at Curtin University until the cause of suspension has been addressed
- Deactivation - Status of a company or individual that immediately requires them to cease all operations at Curtin University

Application of these statuses will be based on outcomes of investigations following any incidents or non-compliances including but not limited to the level, severity and previous performance. A non-compliance is described as “Where a contractor has failed to meet a contractual, legislative or Curtin University requirement”.

Affected companies will be consulted prior to application of any change in their status.
