Information

Curtin University has developed a Health and Hygiene Management Plan (HHMP) to assist in the identification and management of health and hygiene hazards that may affect worker health as a result of exposure to agents, such as atmospheric contaminants, noise and hazardous substances. The HHMP will document identified occupational agents which may cause illness or disease and ensure that implemented controls maintain exposure to as low as practicable.

What will occur?

Proposed implementation will begin February 2019. Health Safety and Emergency Management (HSEM) will contact each work area individually to begin the health and hygiene risk assessment process.

The risk assessment process is as follows -

- The area will receive a risk questionnaire to complete and return to HSEM
- HSEM will conduct a site walk through survey based on the information provided
- HSEM will collate the information from the survey and submit a health and hygiene risk report to the work area.

Should further assessment be required HSEM will notify the work area.

Who will be involved?

HSEM will be in contact with the relevant stakeholders and area Safety and Health Representatives to begin the identification process.
