Background

As a public campus, Curtin is open to the surrounding community and environment. It also supports a student and staff population the size of a small city. To make studying and working at Curtin University an enjoyable and rewarding experience, there are several strategies which can be utilised to enhance your personal safety using the SafeZone app.

Recommendations

Safer Community Team

The Safer Community Team conducts 24/7 patrols and provision of a 24-hour support service every day of the year to the Bentley, and Technology Park. The service comprises a combination of preventative patrols, CCTV surveillance, response to calls, shuttle bus services and security escorts.

There are also emergency telephone stations throughout the campus, along with well-lit, safe pathways and swipe card building access.
