Uninterruptible Power Supply Maintenance

Background

Many areas around Curtin have uninterruptible power supplies (UPS) in place to ensure backup power is supplied to essential computing and research equipment. These may also be known as battery or flywheel backups.

It is essential that regular maintenance programs (usually annual) are in place for UPS to prevent overheating due to cascade battery or charger failure.

Information

Maintenance for all plug-in UPS are to be arranged through the faculty or area. Similarly those UPS that are part of the CITS communications rooms are maintained through CITS. For specific information on the maintenance requirements of these machines, please refer to your manufacturer's Operations Manual or contact the manufacturer.
