Working at Heights Permits

Information

Working at heights includes any work area over two metres or there is a risk of falling two metres or more.

At Curtin, a **Working and Heights Permit** is required to allow personnel to undertake designated works at heights in excess of two metres - this includes works completed on:

- Ladders
- Fixed Work Platforms
- Roof Access
- Scaffolding
- Elevated Work Platforms
- Ceiling Space
